1. ENEMY SITUATION AT END OF PERIOD.

c. Units in contact.- (See POW statement, Par., 3., a. below.).  
Delhi reports that they have evidence that the 33 Army Hq. is now in  
MANGSHIH. (B#2, 5Sept.) ( This makes 3 important Hq in MANGSHIH; 33rd  
Army, 56th Div and 2nd Div.)

2. ENEMY OPERATIONS DURING PERIOD.

u. General summary.- Japs now hold only the Southeast half of  
the Eastern section of TENGCHUNG, including the Southeast gate. (CEF,  
8Sept, C-2). POW, among the 5 who surrendered at TENGCHUNG, said;  
There are 200 combat troops and 300 wounded in the City, remaining of  
the original 1500. This group is Commanded by a Capt. Also re-  
maining with the Japs are 60 Chinese civilians and 30 KOREAN prosti-  
tutes. Commander said, tomorrow, (9th Sept.), they would burn the  
regimental colors and make a suicide attack, POW also said that  
they were in daily radio contact with the Division Hq, at MANGSHIH.  
(33A, 6Sept, F-2). The column of 1000 Japs previously reported North-  
west of TENGCHUNG, broke into 2 columns, one turning on  
the old City of LUNGLING, and the other heading for MANLO Er. Both  
columns have been engaged by units of the Chinese 1st Div. (CEF,  
8Sept, C-2). Only a few and very limited attacks were made in the  
entire Road-block area, by the Japanese, on the 8th, all of which  
were repulsed. (CEF, 8Sept, C-2). Late telephone report from Col.  
Wood stated; Japs attack and cut up the XIGA, right flank, also  
attack the left flank, making a penetrations, which was described  
as not being serious but annoying. (9Sept, B-2).

b. Operation of component elements.-

(5) Aviation combat.- 12 Jap planes, (bombers, fighters, and possi-  
bly Oscars), arrived over FAOSHAN airfield at 081503hrs on a straff-  
ing mission. 2 Jap planes were destroyed, one by AA fire and one by  
P-38. 2 probables. One C-47 was shot down, (carrying 26 Chinese and  
3 Americans, with only 2 Sino soldiers killed and one wounded.) One  
C-47 was destroyed on the field, when a burning Jap plane, crashed  
into it. Another was damaged on the field by enemy fire and one is  
missing. Japs left at 1523hrs. (464AABn, 08Sept, B-2).

3. MISCELLANEOUS.

a. Estimated enemy casualties.- In th LUNGLING, fighting, 10  
Jap casualties were reported. At, SAN KUAN PO, a total of 36 repor-  
ted killed. At TENGCHUNG, 40 were reported killed, but this is believed  
to be an incomplete report. (CEF, 8Sept, C-2). 5 POWs were taken, having  
given themselves up ~~xxxxxxxxxx~~ voluntarily. (Same).

d. Terrain not under our control.- The xhighway between LUNGLING  
and MANGSHIH, is now under construction by over 100 civilian porters  
and the road is said to be servicable as far north as CHANG CHING  
SHAN. (CEF, 9Sept, C-3).

g. Intelligence not covered by other headings.- A POW cap-
